

**St. Clement Church Council Meeting Minutes**  
**Thursday, June 7, 2018**

**Approval of April Minutes:** A motion was made by Sandy Nemeth and seconded by John Pattison – motion carried.

**Old Business:**

**Catholic Ministries Drive 2018 Update:** To date, 125 out of 505 of our families have contributed a total of \$21,420. Our targeted goal is \$42,999 which means, as a parish, we have a 24% participation rate. Father shared the diocesan report which shows a diocesan-wide participation rate of 17.2%. Another mailing from the diocese will be sent out to those who have yet to contribute. Personal stories from those who have benefitted from the various ministries that are supported by this annual drive are being included in the bulletin.

**Parish Council Festival Activity:** Parish Council will chance off several health-related items (3 Fitbits, yoga mat, 1- month YMCA gym membership, and a 1- month West Hills Fitness membership). Additional chances can be earned by completing a hula hoop challenge.

**St. Clement Helping Hand Ministry:** Al suggested the month of August as a tentative time to introduce the ministry to the parish.

**Standing Committees:**

**Finance Council:** No report.

**Maintenance:** New closures were installed on the front doors of the church. The sidewalk project will begin sometime after the church festival. “Mulch Madness” Weekend is June 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> – looking for a great crew to help!

**Liturgy:** There is a need for new Greeters at all the Masses – especially 8:15 AM and 4:00 PM. It is an important ministry as Greeters often are the “first impression” a visitor will have of our parish. Because of the small number of children who attend 8:15 Mass, it is likely that at some point in the future, we will be relying on adults to serve all the Masses. We are slowly progressing towards moving the cry room downstairs and expanding the choir area.

**Family Life:** Kimmi will present a list of ideas for “fun”raising activities for our consideration at the August meeting.

**Christian Service:** Sandy thanked everyone for their help with distributing cupcakes on Pentecost Sunday. We will be looking for someone to assume the job of reporting on Christian Service.

**Pastoral Assistant:** We need MORE volunteers to work at this year’s festival on Sunday, July 15<sup>th</sup>. As members of St. Clement Parish, we are called to be a part of the life of our parish - please sign up for a shift and try to encourage new parishioners to volunteer and join in.

**New Business:**

**Pastors Remarks:** Father reported on the upcoming Arise program. The ARISE Parish Team will have an information booth at the Parish Festival to distribute fliers and answer questions. Father is hopeful that ARISE will be a time of spiritual renewal for the parish, a means of strengthening relationships within our parish family and an incentive for those who are wavering in their faith and commitment to weekly Mass attendance.
