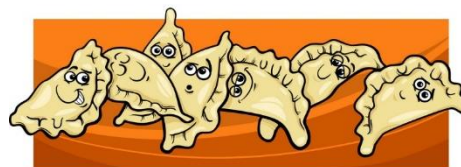
OFFERS A NEW OPPORTUNITY TO CHANGE ONE'S HEART

March 6th - Ash Wednesday - marks the beginning of Lent, the 40 days of preparation for the Easter season when we are called to deepen our spiritual lives through the practices of fasting, prayer, and almsgiving – a time to allow one's heart to be touched and changed by the loving embrace of the Lord.

As you contemplate how you will observe this season of transformation, we invite you to prayerfully consider participating in **Season 2 of ARISE Together in Christ** - "Change Our Hearts." The first session reflects on the central call of Ash Wednesday to conversion. Over the next four sessions, we will explore the meaning of lifelong conversion through the great symbolic themes of the Lenten liturgy: being transfigured; following our thirst for God; living as children of the light; and changing our hearts of stone to hearts of flesh. The last session leads us into Holy Week.
