Dental Missions

"Dentistry with a HEART"

I am writing to invite my parish family to join my husband and me on an exciting mission trip! I took a leap of faith and did something out of the box last year which turned out to be one of the most rewarding opportunities I have encountered! On May 19, 2018, I journeyed to Reading, PA to join an organization called Mission of Mercy of Pennsylvania (MOM of PA). MOM of PA is an organization that sets up an annual dental clinic to provide free dental care to anyone who waits in line, no questions asked. Treatment is provided on a first come, first served basis. In 2018 at the Reading mission, volunteers donated \$1,032,659.00 worth of dental services to over 1900 patients. This year they expect to treat the 10,000th patient since 2013. All of that is not possible without thousands of volunteers!!!

In July of 2018, both my husband and I journeyed to Pittsburgh to do a spinoff of the Pennsylvania Mission of Mercy. At PPG Paints Arena, we participated in the PGH Mission of Mercy. While I treated patients, my husband helped register volunteers and later moved down onto the floor of the arena to be a patient ambassador and escort patients between departments. In 2018, 1,103 patients were served by 1,189 volunteers who performed 4,483 services.

So, I am inviting my parish family to join me in one or both 2019 upcoming Missions of Mercy!! The state Mission of Mercy is coming up very soon in **Wilkes-Barre on Friday, June 7th and Saturday, June 8th. The Pittsburgh Mission will be held on Friday, July 26th and Saturday, July 27th.** While the Wilkes-Barre trip would require an overnight hotel stay, the Pittsburgh Mission could be accomplished by driving directly with an early AM start. Last year, we left Johnstown at 3 AM and arrived before 5 AM so my husband could be there in time for volunteer registration.

General volunteers are needed for patient registration, patient ambassador, patient exit interviewer, volunteer registration, translator, patient and volunteer hospitality, and tech support.

Enough about the details – here is my take from my trips last year. The gratitude expressed to me by the patients cannot be put into words!! My last patient in Pittsburgh was a 74-year old dear lady who could not get over the fact that I drove 2 hours to help her!! She asked if she could pray for me and give thanks for me being there. These patients touched and changed my heart!

Many people travel out of the country on mission trips, but in reality, there are so many people that need help right in our own backyard! I would love to lead a group from our parish to help those in need. Won't you consider joining me and my husband?
