## ST. PATRICK CHURCH FESTIVAL

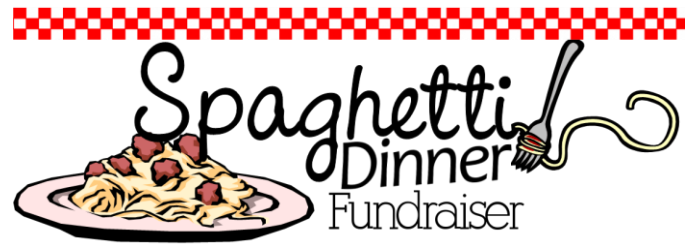
St. Patrick Church (Johnstown) Festival

## HOME NURSING AGENCY HEALING PATCH SEEKS NEW VOLUNTEERS

1 in 7 children in America will lose a parent or sibling by the age of 20. Behind this statistic are real children – who are struggling with difficult emotions like loneliness, fear, and anger. At the Home Nursing Agency Healing Patch, these children find hope and healing are possible through connecting with others. New volunteers are needed to meet the growing number of families finding support at the Healing Patch. While volunteers must understand they are unable to “fix” what has happened, they are able to facilitate activities to help children and adults connect and share their feelings in a safe and welcoming environment. Volunteers are essential for group nights, which occur two evenings a month from September through May. New volunteers receive comprehensive training and have assistance in obtaining necessary clearances. 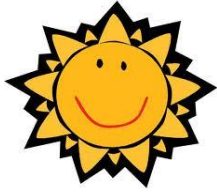

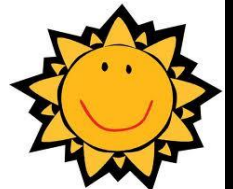
