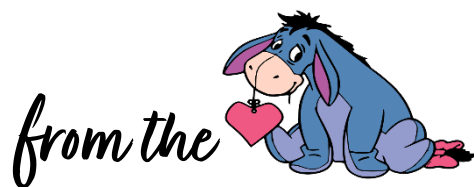

Vegetable



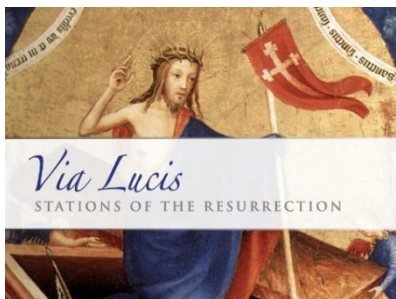
Collection bins will be located at each of the church doors throughout the month of June. All donations are greatly appreciated!
