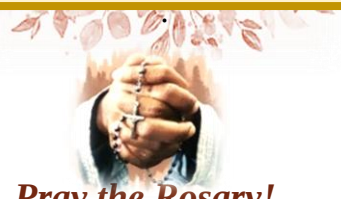

TODAY'S GOSPEL REFLECTION— FIFTH SUNDAY OF EASTER
