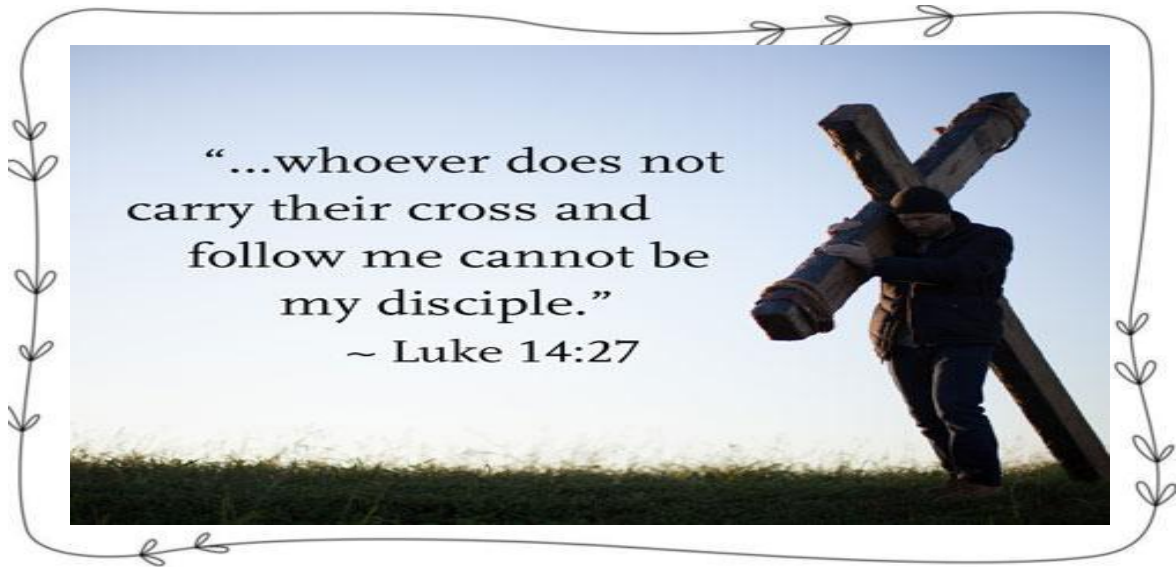

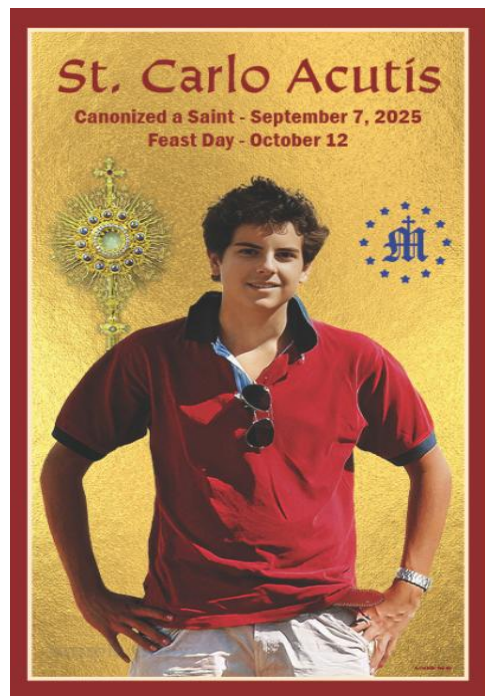

TODAY'S GOSPEL REFLECTION-

23rd SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

Today's readings make very clear the demands that will be made of those wanting to be called disciples of Christ. We must be prepared to give our all to Him. But in the end, the life of discipleship – the stewardship way of life – is the only life that can truly satisfy.

He knows that if we do not live with great intentionality – putting Him first before all else – we will easily be swallowed up by the earthly cares that weigh us down – our material things, our status, and our egos. He knows that these things cannot satisfy us. He knows this because He is our Maker, and He made us for more.

Life Matters: In their November 2018 Pastoral Letter Against Racism, *Open Wide Our Hearts: The Enduring Call to Love*, the U.S. Catholic bishops wrote, "racism occurs because a person ignores the fundamental truth that...all [humans are] equally made in the image of God." Racism fails to acknowledge the dignity with which God creates each person, and it contributes to a culture of death. The Church in the United States has spoken out consistently against abortion, assisted suicide, euthanasia, the death penalty, and other threats to human life.

Marriage: For those who struggle to find meaning in their lives: May they find reassurance in Christ through the loving support of friends and family; We pray to the Lord.

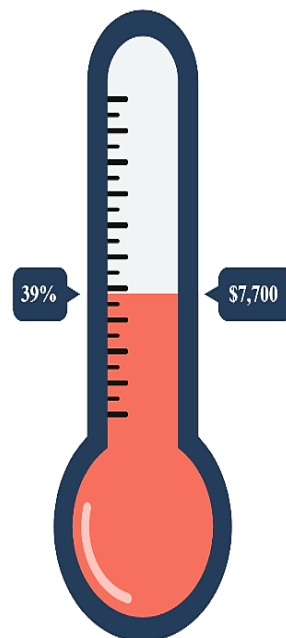
