TODAY'S GOSPEL REFLECTION-
LAST SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST, KING OF THE UNIVERSE.

On this Feast of Christ the King, our readings show us that we serve the greatest of Kings, who is at the same time the humblest of Kings. Christ is the perfect model of servant leadership. 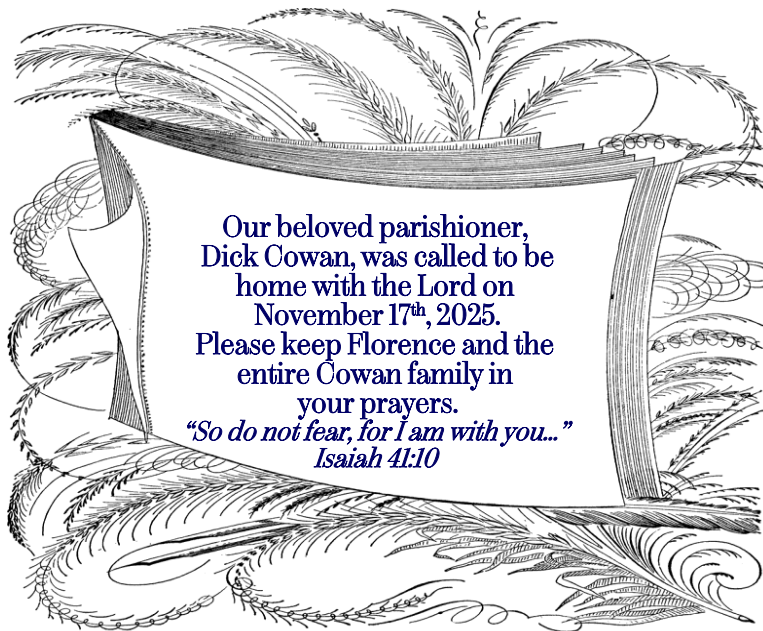
