- 3) For all struggling with difficult family relationships, may the Holy Spirit guide them toward reconciliation, we pray.
- 4) For this community of faith, may we grow in compassion and love through the grace of the Holy Spirit and the example of Jesus, we pray.
- 5) For those who have died marked with the sign of faith, may they come to share in the fullness of eternal life, we pray.
- 6) For all the intentions we hold in our hearts...(pause), we pray.

PRIEST:Loving God, we bring our prayers before you with confidence that you will hear and answer them. Grant what we ask according to your will, through Christ our Lord.

Thursday, May 14, 2026

PRIEST:Let us now bring our petitions before the Lord, who is kind and merciful.

CANTOR: (announce) Our response is “Risen Savior, hear our prayer”.

- 1) For the pope, all bishops, priests, and deacons, may the Holy Spirit continue to sanctify them and conform them to the likeness of Christ, we pray.
- 2) For those who hold elected office, may Jesus inspire in them a greater longing to work for the prosperity of all people, we pray.
- 3) For orphans and children in foster care, may God enfold them with his love and lead them into the care of loving families, we pray.
- 4) For members of this assembly, may Christ help us grow in charity, patience, and humility, we pray.
- 5) For all who have died, may the Father have mercy on their souls and welcome them into his heavenly kingdom, we pray.
- 6) For all the intentions we hold in our hearts...(pause), we pray.

PRIEST:Loving God, we ask that you hear these prayers and answer them in accordance with your providence, through Christ our Lord.
