SUNDAY, JUNE 14, 2026

CANTOR: (announce) Our response is “Lord, hear our prayer”.

- 1) For the Church, may God continue to raise up faithful laborers who will respond to his call, we pray.
- 2) For the world, may the Holy Spirit unite us in God’s peace, we pray.
- 3) For those whose hearts are burdened by sin, and who struggle to trust in God’s mercy and forgiveness, we pray.
- 4) For this faith community, may the Eucharist transform us into a community of prayer, service, and love, we pray.
- 5) For those who have died, may they rejoice with all the angels and saints in heaven, we pray.
- 6) For all the intentions we hold in our hearts...(pause), we pray.

PRIEST:Lord God, hear the prayers of your people and answer them in your goodness. We ask this through Christ our Lord.

SUNDAY, JUNE 21, 2026

PRIEST: Together with one voice, we present our needs to our loving Father.

CANTOR: (announce) Our response is “Lord, hear our prayer”.

- 5) For our beloved dead, may they know the peace of the heavenly kingdom together with all the angels and saints, we pray.
- 6) For all the intentions we hold in our hearts...(pause), we pray.

PRIEST: Loving Father, you call us into communion with you and with each other. We ask you to answer the prayers we make through Christ our Lord.

SUNDAY, JUNE 28, 2026

PRIEST:Let us bring our prayers with confidence to the God who knows all our needs.

CANTOR: (announce) Our response is “Lord, hear our prayer”.

- 2) For leaders of nations, may the Prince of Peace guide them in the ways of peace and reconciliation, we pray.

- 4) For all of us gathered here, may God strengthen us against temptation and graciously hear our prayers for one another, we pray.
- 5) For all who have died, may they rejoice in the eternal light of Christ, we pray.
- 6) For all the intentions we hold in our hearts...(pause), we pray.

PRIEST:God of truth and love, hear these prayers we offer you, we ask, through Christ our Lord.
