**MARRIAGE**- Call Rectory Office at least nine months in advance to arrange.

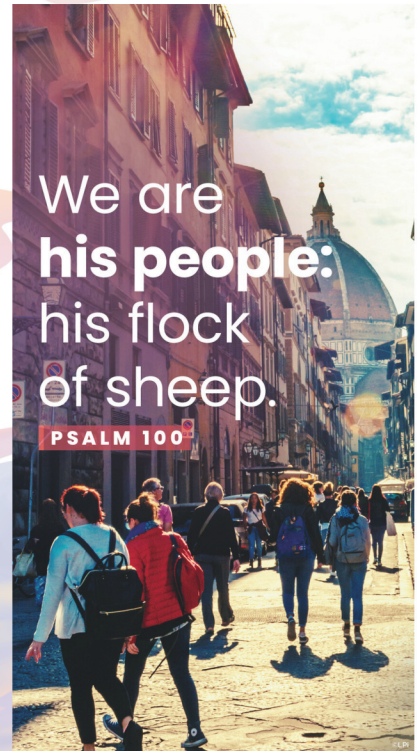
